



TSA Required-Shippers Contract

Dear Sir or Madam,

Recently the TSA (Transportation Security Administration) implemented new security guidelines to prevent or deter the unauthorized introduction of explosives and incendiaries into cargo intended for transportation in air commerce.

Part of these new guidelines requires that we as the freight forwarder can verify that your company is known to us and that you have previously shipped freight with our company.

In the case that no established business history exists between ourselves and a shipper then we are obliged to prepare a shipping contract between both parties, executed at least seven days prior to shipment.

In anticipation of shipping your freight we would ask that you sign and date the relevant sections below and return it to our office by fax as soon as possible.

Unfortunately, your failure to comply with these requests will result in further delays in shipping your freight.

Please note that your signature to this document does not obligate your company to ship your freight with our company. It is simply an acknowledgment that we have discussed the possibility of handling some of your future shipments and that this correspondence is in compliance with the new TSA guidelines.
